Allergen Specification

Product Number: 50500

Description:

Glycine max (Glycine hispida) Gly m 4.0101, also known as stress induced protein SAM22.
Recombinant allergen for in vitro research and manufacturing use only.

Immunological function:

Binds IgE-type human antibodies.

Origin:

Recombinant. Expressed by recombinant baculovirus (*Autographa californica* multiple nuclear polyhedrosis virus; AcMNPV) infection of *Spodoptera frugiperda* Sf9 insect cells.

Expression construct:

Full-length cDNA coding for Gly m 4.0101 fused to a deca-histidine purification tag.

Biochemical tests:

SDS-PAGE (purity > 80%); Western blot with patient sample.

Calculated molecular weight:

19 kDa

Calculated isoelectric point:

pH 5.68

Endotoxin content:

Tested by LAL (Limulus Amoebocyte Lysate) chromogenic endotoxin assay.

Immunological tests/Functionality:

Immunodot analyses with positive/negative samples.

Recommended buffer/storage and handling conditions:

Recommendations for storage buffer: neutral to slightly alkaline pH and 20% glycerol as cryoprotective agent.
Storage conditions: -70°C or below.
Repeated freeze/thaw cycles should be avoided.

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
